"Personal supervision" is defined as time actually spent one-on-one with the Applicant for the exposition and discussion of the law, the recitation of cases, and the critical analysis of the Applicant's written assignments.
  - (3) The time and manner we expect to devote to evaluating the Applicant's progress, including developing, administering, and grading the examinations at the conclusion of each subject. Graded examinations are to be submitted with the quarterly certificates within fifteen (15) working days of the end of the quarter in which the subject is completed.
