

Military Spouse Provisional Admission Application Instructions

1. Read Before You Begin

Read Supreme Court of Virginia [Rule 1A:8](#) and the full [Military Spouse Provisional Admission \(MSPA\) Application Instructions](#) before starting your Application.

2. Application Process Overview

- Complete the online MSPA Application and Character & Fitness Questionnaire.

Note: When the Application is complete, you will see a green check on your User Home page. If any answers are missing, you will see a red exclamation point (!). Click the exclamation point to see which sections are missing answers. You may stop and save your progress at any time while completing your Application.

- Upload all required documents before submitting your Application online.
- Submit online, then print (single-sided) and mail the Application, Character & Fitness Questionnaire, fee, and all required/additional documents (e.g., driving record, credit report) to the Board's office. **Note: Your Application will not be considered properly filed until the printed Application, Character & Fitness Questionnaire, fee, and all documents are received by the Board's office.** Incomplete or inaccurate submissions may delay processing or affect character and fitness review.

3. Required & Additional Documents

You **must upload and mail** all documents with your Application and Character & Fitness Questionnaire to the Board's office.

Click the "Required Documents" button on your User Home Page to upload documents.

Required Documents

- Application fee (money order, cashier's check, or certified check only)
- NCBE Number confirmation
- Driving record(s)
- Credit report
- Birth certificate or proof of citizenship/immigration status
- Certificate(s) of Good Standing from every jurisdiction of licensure
- Certificate(s) of Discipline

- Law School Transcript
- Copy of spouse's military orders
- Copy of military dependent ID card
- Proof of Virginia residence
- Virginia MCLE Board Certification of Attendance
- Virginia Rules of Professional Conduct Affidavit (original)
- Authorization & Release Form (original)

Additional Documents (if applicable)

- Marriage certificate, divorce decree, or name change order
- Military service records
- Court records for criminal matters, judgments, or liens
- Bankruptcy or defaulted student loan documentation
- Character & Fitness Healthcare Form

4. Mailing Your Application & Documents

You must print and mail your completed Application forms, with fee and all required/additional documents to the Board's office:
